A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE SUMMIT/AKRON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY ("AUTHORITY") FOR A COMMUNITY RECYCLING ACCESS GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Green ("Green") desires to implement and support new and existing community recycling programs that assist the Authority in meeting the goals and objectives of the State of Ohio's Solid Waste Management Plan and the Authority's approved Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has developed the Community Recycling Access Grant ("Grant") to support projects which would sustain and increase recycling activities within Summit County; and

WHEREAS, Green City Council received a recommendation that Green apply to the Authority for the Grant to further the goals of sustaining and increasing recycling activities within Summit County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes the Mayor, **ON AN ONGOING BASIS**, to ~~apply~~ **FILE APPLICATIONS** ~~to~~ **WITH** the Authority for a Community Recycling Access Grant for recycling activities within Summit County.

SECTION TWO:

City Council directs the Clerk of Council to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Authority, c/o Jenny Markovich, Program Coordinator, The Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority, 12 East Exchange Street, Third Floor, Akron, Ohio 44308.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or
