FINANCE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO DISPOSE OF UNUSED AND UNNEEDED CITY ASSETS BY SUBMITTING THEM FOR BID ON E-BAY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, over time, the City accumulates many unused and unneeded equipment that has been replaced and/or broken; and

WHEREAS, in the past, the City has conducted auctions at a City facility to dispose of this equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City could expose the unused and unneeded equipment to a wider audience by placing the items for bid on e-Bay; and

WHEREAS, other communities have used e-Bay to dispose of their assets; and

WHEREAS, it is the City's desire to use e-Bay to dispose of unused and unneeded City equipment and other assets; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for City Council to approve this method of disposing of these assets.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes the City to pursue and use e-Bay to dispose of unused and unneeded equipment and other assets of the City. City Council also intends for this Resolution to apply to all future disposal of equipment in all future years so that a new Resolution does not need to be passed each year by Council to dispose of unused and unneeded equipment via e-Bay.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
