A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF A LANDMARK DESIGNATION APPLICATION FOR THE KLINEFELTER CEMETERY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green applied to the Historic Preservation Commission to designate, as an historic local landmark, the Klinefelter Cemetery, located at the Southeast corner of Arlington and E. Nimisila Roads, City of Green, State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission reviewed the application and found it to be in compliance with Chapter 278 of the City of Green codified Ordinances, including Section 278.05, establishing criteria for landmark designation; and

WHEREAS, the funerary dates from 1812 (earliest known date), has not been significantly altered since that time and was owned by Adam Klinefelter, a pioneer minister of the Evangelical Association in Green; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission found that the characteristics specific to this funerary represent both architectural and historic significance as described in Section 278.02(g) of the City of Green Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, after a public hearing on September 18, 2007, the Historic Preservation Commission recommended approval of the landmark application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council approves the Historic Preservation Commission's designation of the Klinefelter Cemetery as a historic landmark.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
