

**RESOLUTION NO.:** 2007-R17

**A RESOLUTION RE-APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE SOUTHGATE FARM, AUTHORIZING THE RECLASSIFICATION OF THE PAYMENT FOR THE PROPERTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City's agreement for the purchase of Southgate Farm required the City to complete the purchase by February 1, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City paid the remaining amount due for the purchase of the property and now owns all of the property known as Southgate Farm; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the City will not receive additional federal grant funding for the purchase of the Southgate Farm property, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds in the Parks Capital Reserve Fund to cover the reclassified purchase of the Southgate Farm property; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to reclassify the expenditure of this purchase to the proper funds; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

City Council has been advised that a previously awarded federal grant for the purchase of the Southgate Farm has been withdrawn. City Council approves the reduction of appropriations of Five Hundred Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$502,500) Dollars from the Southgate Federal Payment account (Account # 232-7810-54820) in the Grant Project Fund.

**SECTION TWO:**

City Council approves the appropriation of Five Hundred Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$502,500) Dollars into the Southgate Farm Purchase account (account # 402-6000-53610), to cover the reclassified purchase of the Southgate Farm property, from the unappropriated balance of the Parks Capital Reserve Fund.

**SECTION THREE:**

City Council approves the reclassification of a portion of the prior payment made to the Beldens for the purchase of the Southgate Farm to be charged to the Southgate Farm Purchase account ( # 402-6000-53610).

**SECTION FOUR:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION FIVE:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
