INTRODUCED: MARCH 13, 2007

A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING MARLENE BRAUNLICH ON THE OCCASION OF HER RETIREMENT FROM THE CITY AFTER 17 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Marlene Braunlich has, with sincere devotion and professional commitment, faithfully served the City of Green and its citizens beginning on September 13, 1989, when Green was then a Township; and

WHEREAS, Marlene Braunlich initially worked as Secretary to the Planning & Zoning Commission prior to the establishment of a Planning Department. She eventually served as Administrative Secretary to the Planning Director, and was then transferred to the Zoning Division as a Code Inspector. Marlene eventually rounded out her employment with the City of Green as a Tax Clerk in the Income Tax Division; and

WHEREAS, Marlene Braunlich has developed a full and rich life in which to retire, to include traveling with her husband Ken, enjoying her friends in both the Red Hat Society and the Beta Sigma Phi Sorority, and spending time with her beautiful grandson, Alex; and

WHEREAS, Marlene Braunlich has witnessed many changes in the City over the past seventeen (17) years, and has served the City well, in many capacities, throughout these changes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The Council, on behalf of the City, congratulates Marlene Braunlich on the occasion of her retirement from the City after many years of dedicated service to the City of Green and wishes her all the best in the future.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare for the reason that, after seventeen years, recognition of Marlene Braunlich is long overdue, and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
