A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO NORTHSTAR ASPHALT FOR THE CASTON ROAD WIDENING AND BIKE LANE ADDITION PROJECT ("PROJECT"), MAKING AN APPROPRIATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a "Notice to Bidders" in the Akron Beacon Journal on April 1, 2011 and April 8, 2011; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, April 22, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Northstar Asphalt as the lowest and best bidder for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on Friday, April 22, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.:

SECTION TWO:

City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, that Northstar Asphalt is the lowest and best bidder for the Project and has agreed to comply with all specifications for same.

SECTION THREE:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into agreements with Northstar Asphalt for the Project and awards a contract for \$1,997,564.85, for Alternative 5 that includes the Arlington/Caston signal. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to Northstar Asphalt through the established purchase order procedures.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council approves the appropriations of One Hundred Sixty-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$167,621.00) to the Caston/Arlington Rd Improvement Account (203-2900-53633) from the unappropriated balance of the Permissive Auto Fund.

SECTION FIVE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION SIX:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. The City needs to begin purchasing the needed materials immediately. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
