

ORDINANCE NO.: 2009-2

INTRODUCED: FEBRUARY 10, 2009

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 1068.01 OF GREEN'S CODIFIED ORDINANCES REGARDING RENTAL FEES FOR THE JOHN TOROK COMMUNITY AND SENIOR CENTER, GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH FEES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in 1997 City Council adopted Resolution 1997-R67 which established rental fees for the use of the John Torok Community and Senior Center previously known as the Green Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the fees set forth in the Resolution are no longer the fees charged for the use of the facility; and

WHEREAS, numerous factors affect the fees charged for the facility, including utilities costs; and

WHEREAS, the fees charged for the use of this facility are best determined by the Service Department, which is in charge of operating and maintaining City-owned facilities; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City to still provide use of the facility to tax-exempt organizations for no charge and at a reduced rate for Green residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Section 1068.01 of Green's Codified Ordinances is repealed.

SECTION TWO:

The Service Department, which includes the Parks and Recreation Division, shall, from the date of this Ordinance, determine the fair rental fees for the use of the John Torok Community and Senior Center, and publish those fees as it deems appropriate.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this City and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
