A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR VARIOUS ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE 2013 CALENDAR YEAR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City routinely contracts for various types of engineering services; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the passage of Ordinance 2010-04, it is necessary for City Council to approve the hiring of engineering firms for these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes the Engineering Department to enter into a contract(s) with Thrasher Engineering NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000 (General Engineering); Hammontree & Associates NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000 (General Engineering); Quicksall & Associates NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000 (General Engineering); Mosyjowski & Associates NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000 (General Engineering); TMS Engineers NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000 (General Traffic Services); Summit Testing NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000 (**GENERAL ENGINEERING**); ~~for engineering services~~ **MUNICIPAL SERVICES GROUP, INC. NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000 \$325,000 (General Engineering)** for the calendar year of 2013.

Services may include storm drainage projects including storm pipes, retention/detention facilities, and flood plain map revisions; transportation projects including streets, bridges, traffic signal designs/studies to assist the City with signal operations and project planning; surveying, various soil borings, pavement cores and material testing.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. The City must be able to proceed immediately to enlist the necessary engineering services in the calendar year 2013. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
