A RESOLUTION AWARDDING CONTRACTS TO NORTHSTAR ASPHALT FOR MATERIALS 448 TYPE 1, 448 TYPE 2 AND 301, AND MASSILLON ASPHALT FOR TACK, FOR THE 2012 ROAD ASPHALT MATERIALS PROJECT (“PROJECT”), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a “Notice to Bidders” in the Akron Beacon Journal on May 22, 2012 and May 29, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2012, the City Deputy Director of Public Service opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Deputy Director of Public Service has reviewed the bids and recommends the contracts be awarded to Northstar Asphalt for Materials 448 Type 1, 448 Type 2 and 301, and Massillon Asphalt for Tack, as the lowest and best bidders for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on June 1, 2012:

SECTION TWO:

City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, including, but not limited to, the cost of pick-up and delivery of the materials, that Northstar Asphalt and Massillon Asphalt are the lowest and best bidders for the Project and have agreed to comply with all specifications for same.

SECTION THREE:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into agreements with Northstar Asphalt and Massillon Asphalt for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to Northstar Asphalt and Massillon Asphalt through the established purchase order procedures.

SECTION FOUR:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FIVE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. The City needs to begin purchasing the needed materials immediately. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
