A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO APPLY FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE MUSKINGUM WATERSHED CONSERVANCY DISTRICT FOR THE STEESE ROAD EDUCATIONAL WETLAND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District administers financial assistance for conservation purposes through the Partners in Watershed Management Project Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green desires financial assistance under the Partners in Watershed Management Project Assistance Program administered through the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes the City of Green to file an application for financial assistance and enter into a Grant Agreement. The Mayor is authorized to execute and file an application with the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance. City Council agrees to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Partners in Watershed Management Project Assistance Program.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
