A RESOLUTION AWARDED A CONTRACT TO SPANO BROTHERS CONSTRUCTION FOR THE BOETTLER ROAD INLET & CATCH BASIN REPAIR/ REBUILD PROJECT ("PROJECT"), MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF TWO HUNDRED SEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY NINE DOLLARS AND TWENTY ONE CENTS (\$207,659.21), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a "Notice to Bidders" in the Akron Beacon Journal on Thursday, December 5, 2013; Thursday, December 12, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, December 20, 2013, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Spano Brothers Construction as the lowest and best bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate additional funds to award the contract for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on December 20, 2013:

SECTION TWO:

City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, Spano Brothers Construction is the lowest and best bidder for the Project and agrees to comply with all specifications.

SECTION THREE:

City Council authorizes the appropriation of Two Hundred Seven Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Nine Dollars and Twenty One Cents (\$207,659.21) to the Boettler Road Inlet & Catch Basin Repair/Rebuild Project Account (201-2300-53637) from the unappropriated balance of the Street Construction & Maintenance Fund.

SECTION FOUR:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into agreement with Spano Brothers Construction for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to Spano Brothers Construction through the established purchase order procedures.

SECTION FIVE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION SIX:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
