**A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO ADVANCED DRAINAGE SYSTEMS FOR THE 2008 STORM WATER MATERIALS PROJECT ("PROJECT"), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a "Notice to Bidders" in the Akron Beacon Journal on July 15, 2008 and July 22, 2008; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, July 29, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. the Highway Superintendent received and opened sealed bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Highway Superintendent has reviewed the bids and recommends that a contract be awarded to Advanced Drainage Systems for the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

The following are the bids received and opened on Tuesday, June 17, 2008 at 1:30 p.m.:

**SECTION TWO:**

City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, that Advanced Drainage Systems is the lowest and best bidder for the Project and has agreed to comply with all specifications.

**SECTION THREE:**

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Advanced Drainage Systems for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Advanced Drainage Systems through the established purchase order procedures.

**SECTION FOUR:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION FIVE:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
