**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE FOR PROPERTY OWNERS ALONG SOUTH MAIN STREET TO HOOK UP TO THE NEW SANITARY SEWER INSTALLED AS PART OF THE SOUTH MAIN STREET WIDENING PROJECT ("PROJECT"), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Green and Summit County approved and constructed the South Main Street Widening Project in the City of Green which included the installation of sanitary sewer; and

WHEREAS, property owners along the Project will be assessed for the cost of sanitary sewer; and

WHEREAS, City Council, through Resolution 2004-R37, authorized a program to underwrite the cost of the sanitary sewer on South Main Street so property owners along the length of the Project are not unduly burdened by the assessment for sanitary sewer and extended the program for an additional year by Resolution 2006-R77; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green desires to extend the time for property owners to hook up to the sanitary sewer at a reduced cost.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

City Council authorizes the Mayor to extend the deadline for residents and businesses to hook up to the sanitary sewer and receive a reduced assessment as follows:

- (A) The City will "buy-down" the assessed cost for property owners that hook up to the sanitary sewer by September 1, 2009. Any property owner that hooks up to the sanitary sewer prior to September 1, 2009 will assessed fifty (50%) percent of the full benefit cost. Any property owner that does not connect with the sanitary sewer system by September 1, 2009 will be assessed seventy-five (75%) percent of the full benefit cost.

**SECTION TWO:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION THREE:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
