

RESOLUTION NO.: 2013-R43 (AMENDED JUNE 25, 2013)
SPONSOR: MAYOR NORTON
INTRODUCED: JUNE 11, 2013 **ASSIGNED TO:** FINANCE

A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO NORTHSTAR ASPHALT FOR THE IN HOUSE PAVING PROJECT (“PROJECT”), MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a “Notice to Bidders” for the Project in the Akron Beacon Journal on Wednesday, May 16, 2013 and Wednesday, May 23, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, May 31, 2013, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Northstar Asphalt as the lowest and best bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has determined it necessary to appropriate additional funds for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on Friday, May 31, 2013:

SECTION TWO:

City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, Northstar Asphalt is the lowest and best bidder for the Project and agrees to comply with all specifications.

SECTION THREE:

Green City Council further authorizes the appropriation of One Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$178,120.00) to the Heckman Road Resurfacing Account (201-2100-53634) from the unappropriated balance of the Street Construction & Maintenance Fund for the services provided by Northstar Asphalt.

SECTION FOUR THREE:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into agreement with Northstar Asphalt for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to Northstar Asphalt through the established purchase order procedures.

SECTION FIVE FOUR:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION SIX FIVE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
