A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A DONATION TO THE GREEN HISTORICAL SOCIETY, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Green Historical Society researches, discovers, and shares local and regional historic information for the City of Green; and

WHEREAS, the Green Historical Society provides educational services to Green Schools and local clubs and supports the research efforts of groups and individuals; and

WHEREAS, the Green Historical Society provides local programming highlighting local and regional history and airs recordings of these events on local cable Channel 16; and

WHEREAS, the Green Historical Society assists property owners with local landmark applications; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green desires to donate Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) to the Green Historical Society to focus on these core functions for the 2014 calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes and approves a donation of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) from the City of Green to the Green Historical Society for the core functions of the Green Historical Society identified in the whereas clauses to this Resolution.

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council requests the Finance Director to make the donation to the Green Historical Society at the earliest time permitted by law.

SECTION THREE:

Green City Council authorizes an appropriation of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund to the Green Historical Society Account (#100-5110-52416).

SECTION FOUR:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION SIX:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
