**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE 2012 ROAD RESURFACING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City routinely contracts for engineering services to evaluate the roadways and determine the roads which need resurfacing; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to obtain engineering services for the 2012 Road Resurfacing Program and various traffic engineering services; and

WHEREAS, those engineering firm(s) will also provide plans and specifications for repairs and inspection services during construction; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the passage of Ordinance 2010-04, it is necessary for City Council to approve the hiring of an engineer for these services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

City Council authorizes the Engineering Department to enter into a contract(s) with KCI Technologies **NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000**, Summit Testing **NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000** and TMS Engineers **NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000** for engineering services for the 2012 Road Resurfacing Program and various traffic engineering projects. The services will include coring and evaluation of existing pavement materials, evaluation of roadway sub-base, providing preparation of plans and specifications for sub-base repairs and inspection services during construction, as well as perform various traffic studies to assist the City with signal operations and project planning.

**SECTION TWO:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION THREE:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. The City must be able to proceed immediately to enlist the necessary engineering services in order to complete the necessary road resurfacings and various traffic engineering projects in the calendar year 2012. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
