INTRODUCED: AUGUST 14, 2012 **ASSIGNED TO:** FINANCE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF A REPAIR INVOICE TO DOUG CHEVROLET FOR A 2012 CHEVROLET SILVERADO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City is required to have an authorized Purchase Order in place before the payment of invoices; and

WHEREAS, the City needed to repair its 2012 Chevrolet Silverado as a result of a minor accident; and

WHEREAS, due to a clerical mistake, the Purchase Order was not processed and approved prior to the completion of the repair and the receipt of the repair invoice from Doug Chevrolet; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to obtain Council's approval for the payment of the invoice since the Purchase Order was not approved prior to the date of the invoice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City of Council approves the payment of the repair invoice to Doug Chevrolet in the amount of Four Thousand Seven Dollars and Fifty-Eight Cents (\$4,007.58) for necessary repair to comply with Ohio Law with respect to the payment invoices without a properly completed and dated purchase order.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
