**A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE COMMITMENT OF LOCAL MATCH FUNDS FOR THE MOVING OHIO FORWARD GRANT PROGRAM, PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED BY RESOLUTION 2012-R25, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Ohio Attorney General created the Moving Ohio Forward Program (“Program”) to assist Communities with demolishing abandoned, vacant and blighted residential properties; and

WHEREAS, \$3,780,560 was allocated to Summit County and the Program requires a 1-to-1 match from local funds; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2012-R25, City Council authorized the City to participate in the Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program, and committed local match funds in the amount of \$15,000.00 for the Program; and

WHEREAS, Green is eligible to receive a total of \$83,000.00 from the Program, including its Matching Funds obligation to \$15,000.00; and

WHEREAS, after Green matches \$15,000.00 under the Program, the Program will reimburse an additional amount of \$53,000.00 without any matching funds from the City; and

WHEREAS, the Program requires Green to advance the funds for demolition before receiving reimbursement from the Program; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has already identified several projects that will fully exhaust the commitment previously authorized by City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Administration desires to authorize additional funds for more potential projects subject to the Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION ONE**

City Council approves an additional commitment of local match funds in the amount of \$68,000.00 toward the Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program. City Council authorizes a commitment letter to be sent to the County of Summit by Mayor Norton pledging the commitment of additional funds.

**SECTION TWO**

City Council authorizes the appropriation of \$68,000.00 from the unappropriated balance of the Planning Fund to the Contract Services Account (247-5100-52412).

**SECTION THREE**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this City and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION FOUR**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
