A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER FOR THE 2011 PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROGRAM, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, City Council, by Resolution 2011-R41 awarded a contract to Northstar Asphalt for the 2011 Pavement Resurfacing Program ("Program"); and

WHEREAS, City desires to amend the agreement to accommodate additional pavement repairs on Arlington Road, under Interstate 77; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to the contract for this Program will allow for the City to complete the necessary repairs during calendar year 2012 and is the most economical and efficient way to accomplish the work that is necessary; and

WHEREAS, Green Codified Ordinance Section 2010.06(e) requires City Council's approval since the amendment to the agreement exceeds Ten Percent (10%) of the original contract amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes Mayor Norton to enter into a Change Order with Northstar Asphalt for the 2011 Road Resurfacing Program in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$155,000.00). City Council further appropriates Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) a unappropriated balance of the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund to the 2011 Pavement Resurfacing Account (201-2100-53630) to provide sufficient funds for this Change Order.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. The City must be able to proceed immediately to enlist the necessary engineering services in order to complete the necessary road resurfacings during the remainder of the paving season in the calendar year 2011. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
