A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF SNOW AND ICE MATERIALS, MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE BOETTLER PARK HILL TOP PAVILION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2008, City Council unanimously adopted Resolution 2008-R41 which authorized the City to participate in the Northeast Ohio Sourcing Office's 2008-2009 Salt Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2008-R41, the City immediately desires to order snow and ice materials for the upcoming 2008-2009 winter season; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to transfer funds from the General Fund to the Street Construction and Maintenance Fund for the purchase; and

WHEREAS, it is also necessary to appropriate funds to the Snow and Ice Materials Account (201-2210-52511) and authorize the payment of invoices for road salt ordered and received to date that exceed the original appropriation level; and

WHEREAS, the City also needs an additional appropriation for the Boettler Park Hill Top Pavilion Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes the transfer of Two Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$255,000.00) Dollars from the General Fund to the Street Construction and Maintenance Fund. City Council further authorizes the appropriation of Two Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$255,000.00) Dollars to the Snow and Ice Materials Account (201-2210-52511) from the unappropriated balance of the Street Construction and Maintenance Fund. City Council also authorizes the payment of all invoices for road salt ordered and received to date that exceed the original appropriation level.

SECTION TWO:

City Council authorizes an additional appropriation of Nineteen Thousand Three Hundred Forty-eight Dollars (\$19,348.00) to the Boettler Pavilion Account (402-7800-53633) from the unappropriated Parks Capital Project Fund.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
