A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING WITH SUMMIT COUNTY FOR THE CAPITAL, INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITY IMPROVEMENT PORTION OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM ("CDBG") 2009 PROGRAM YEAR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green participates with Summit County in the 2009 Program Year of the federally funded Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the County has provided to the City information relative to eligible projects and areas of the City in relation to utilization of CDBG funds; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined the need to provide funds for the CDBG 2009 Program Year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The Planning Department is authorized and directed to submit an application with the Summit County Department of Development and to provide all information and documentation required for submission to Summit County for the CDBG 2009 Program Year.

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into and execute any contracts necessary to facilitate the City's participation in the CDBG 2009 Program Year.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this City and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
