A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ("FEMA") TO PURCHASE A NEW PUMPER FOR THE FIRE DIVISION, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Fire Division previously received a federal grant to purchase a new Pumper vehicle for Two Hundred Seventy-three Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$273,600.00); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the grant, the City must exercise its rights under the grant and purchase the pumper; and

WHEREAS, if the City does not proceed expeditiously to use the grant funds to purchase the pumper, the grant will be lost; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to appropriate these grant funds toward the cost of the Pumper in the amount of Two Hundred Seventy-three Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$273,600.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council approves the appropriation of Two Hundred Seventy-three Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$273,600.00) out of the Pumper Truck account (232-3220-53650) from the unappropriated funds of the federal grant fund.

SECTION TWO:

Council also approves the advance of the payment of the purchase price to the vendor in exchange for the vendor's agreement to pay interest to the City at the rate of 6.5% per annum on the amount advanced from the date of payment to the date of delivery of the new Pumper.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this City and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this

legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
