A RESOLUTION AWARDDING A CONTRACT TO NORTHSTAR ASPHALT FOR THE ARLINGTON ROAD/ARLINGTON RIDGE RESURFACING PROJECT (“PROJECT”), MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a “Notice to Bidders” for the Project in the Akron Beacon Journal on Thursday, July 11, 2013 and Thursday, July 18, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, July 26, 2013, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Northstar Asphalt as the lowest and best bidder for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on Friday, July 26, 2013:

2. Lockhart Concrete Co. 800 W. Waterloo Road Akron, Ohio 44314	\$1,006,568.50

SECTION TWO:

City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, Northstar Asphalt is the lowest and best bidder for the Project and agrees to comply with all specifications.

SECTION THREE:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into agreement with Northstar Asphalt for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to Northstar Asphalt through the established purchase order procedures.

SECTION FOUR:

City Council authorizes an additional appropriation of Three Hundred Ninety Five Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Four Dollars (\$395,794.00) to the Arlington Road/Arlington Ridge Resurfacing Project account (403-8020-53639) from the unencumbered available balance of the TIF Fund.

SECTION FIVE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION SIX:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
