**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMENDMENT TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY 9-1-1 PLAN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Copley Township, the City of Norton, and the City of Barberton formed the Southwest Summit Council of Governments which also involved the consolidation of public safety communications among those communities. This consolidation created a new public safety answering point for those communities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5507.12(4), Summit County 9-1-1 Planning Committee met and approved the Southwest Summit Council of Governments; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5507.08(A), the City of Green, as a municipality within the Summit County 9-1-1 Plan, must approve the amendment to that plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

Green City Council approves the amendment to the Summit County 9-1-1 Plan which recognizes the Southwest Summit Council of Governments and the new public safety answering point created for Copley Township, the City of Norton, and the City of Barberton. A copy of the amendment is attached as Exhibit "A".

**SECTION TWO:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION THREE:**


Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.


