**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE
A USED 2004 GMC 7500 BUCKET TRUCK WITHOUT COMPETITIVE
BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Green needs to purchase a used 2004 GMC 7500 Bucket truck for use by its Parks and Recreation and Highway Divisions; and

WHEREAS, the City has diligently searched for and located a used Bucket truck which has all of the accessories needed by the City and is in proper condition; and

WHEREAS, the City may lose the opportunity to purchase this equipment if it pursues the formal bidding process necessary to purchase a capital asset in excess of \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS, competitive bidding to purchase the truck equipment will not yield multiple bids because the specifications and condition of the truck and equipment are unique; and, after a diligent search, the City has been unable to located another unit with similar specifications and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Administration desires Council approval to purchase the 2004 GMC 7500 Bucket truck without using the formal bidding processes; and

WHEREAS, the Revised Code authorizes the purchase of used equipment by a municipality without bid in certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the Revised Code requires Council to approve a purchase of used equipment without bid.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes the City of Green to purchase a used 2004 GMC 700 Bucket truck for use by its Service Department; specifically, it's Highway and Parks and Recreation Divisions, and further authorizes the purchase of that equipment without the formal bidding processes set forth in Chapter 210 of Green's Codified Ordinances.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. If the City is required to use the competitive bidding process, it may lose the opportunity to purchase the used 2004 GMC 7500 Bucket truck. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
