Whereas, Green Youth Football players, managers, coaches, officials, parents, and countless others work together in an atmosphere of wholesome community activity to provide entertainment for the spectators; and

Whereas, Green Youth Football has won twenty-four Suburban Youth Football Championships with the most recent being in 2007; and

Whereas, our city is proud of the record that Green Youth Football has earned and the fine publicity they have brought to our community by their good sportsmanship and inspired team play; and

The Council, on behalf of the City, congratulates Green Youth Football for 50 years of dedicated service to the youth of the City of Green.


**SECTION TWO:**



**SECTION THREE:**


