**A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO DURA MARK, INC. FOR THE 2008 ROAD STRIPING PROJECT ("PROJECT"), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a "Notice to Bidders" in the Akron Beacon Journal on July 18, 2008 and July 25, 2008; and

WHEREAS, on Monday, August 4, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. the Highway Superintendent received and opened sealed bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Highway Superintendent has reviewed the bids and recommends that a contract be awarded to Dura Mark, Inc. for the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

The following are the bids received and opened on Monday, August 4, 2008 at 10:00 a.m.:

**SECTION THREE:**

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Dura Mark, Inc. for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Dura Mark, Inc. through the established purchase order procedures.

**SECTION FOUR:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION FIVE:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
