

RESOLUTION NO.: 2013-R12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO RESURFACE 6.1 MILES OF STATE ROUTE 619 AND REPLACE THE STRUCTURE OVER THE TUSCARAWAS RIVER PROJECT (“PROJECT”) WITHIN THE CITY OF GREEN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on November 9, 2010, the City of Green enacted legislation proposing cooperation with the Director of Transportation to resurface 6.1 miles of State Route 619 and replace the structure over the Tuscarawas River lying within the City of Green; and

WHEREAS, Green’s share of the cost for the Project is now estimated to be Three Hundred Eighty Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$387,980.00). The estimated amount is to be adjusted so that the City of Green’s ultimate share of improvement shall correspond with the percentages of actual costs when the actual costs are determined; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation has approved the legislation proposing cooperation and has reviewed the plans, specifications, costs and expenses for the Project; and

Whereas, the City of Green authorizes the Director of Transportation to proceed with the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City of Green finds that the proposed Project serves the public interest and gives its consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the Project.

SECTION TWO:

The estimated sum of Three Hundred Eighty Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$387,980.00) is appropriated for the Project and the Finance Department is authorized and directed to issue a purchase order for the sum upon the requisition of the Director of Transportation to pay the cost and expenses of the Project. The City of Green agrees to share the cost and expense over and above the amount paid from Federal Funds.

SECTION THREE:

The Mayor shall enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation which is necessary to complete the Project.

SECTION FOUR:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any

deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FIVE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. It is necessary to immediately pass this Resolution to expedite the proposed Project and promote highway safety. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
