

RESOLUTION NO.: 2012-R43

INTRODUCED: AUGUST 28, 2012 **ASSIGNED TO:** FINANCE

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER FOR THE HARTONG HOUSE REHABILITATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, City Council, by Resolution 2012-R12, awarded a contract to Danmark Construction for the Hartong House Rehabilitation Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City expects the total cost for the completion of the Project to exceed the original contract price by Nine Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$9,100.00) which is more than Ten percent (10%) of the original contract price; and

WHEREAS, Green Codified Ordinance Section 210.06(e) requires City Council's approval since the amendment to the agreement exceeds Ten percent (10%) of the original contract amount; and

WHEREAS, the City has taken the steps to appropriate the necessary money to complete the Project by amending the appropriation through Resolution 2012-R30.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City of Council authorizes Mayor Norton to enter into a change order with Danmark Construction for the Project in an amount not to exceed Nine Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$9,100.00).

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
