A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO REIMBURSE THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ("FEMA") FOR A PORTION OF THE FUNDS AWARDED TO THE CITY OF GREEN BY GRANT IN 2004, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in 2004, the City applied for and received a grant from FEMA to purchase protective clothing and self-contained-breathing apparatus; and

WHEREAS, FEMA ultimately reduced the City's grant award from the amount requested (\$206,310.00) to \$166,315.70; and

WHEREAS, FEMA also reduced the grant award to limit it to thirty (30) sets of gear, thirty (30) self-contained-breathing apparatus, and thirty (30) voice emitters, making the total amount of the grant to the City of Green \$149,684.13; and

WHEREAS, the City ultimately purchased a different amount of protective clothing and self-contained-breathing apparatus than allowed by the grant, as approved; and

WHEREAS, due to the City's different purchase, the amount of \$35,994.87 needs to be returned to FEMA pursuant to the terms of the grant; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make an appropriation from the Fire Fund to issue a refund to FEMA.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes the appropriation of Thirty-five Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Four Dollars and 87/100 (\$35,994.87) to the Protective Clothing Account (210-3300-53643) from the unappropriated balance of the Fire Fund to reimburse FEMA a portion of the funds awarded pursuant to the grant issued to the City of Green (known as Grant Number ENW-2004-FG-08057).

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
