A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE 2011 ANNUAL CAPITAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY OF GREEN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the general laws of the State of Ohio, it is necessary to adopt a Capital Appropriation Resolution for the operation of the City of Green for fiscal year 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council approves and adopts the 2011 Capital Appropriations for the City of Green as contained in **AMENDED** Exhibit "A" (attached).

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
