A RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACTS TO PS CONSTRUCTION FABRIC FOR THE 2012 CRACK SEALING PROJECTS ("PROJECT"), MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a "Notice to Bidders" in the Akron Beacon Journal on July 5, 2012, and July 12, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2012, the City Deputy Director of Public Service opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Deputy Director of Public Service has reviewed the bids and recommends the contracts be awarded to PS Construction Fabric as the lowest and best bidder for the Project.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate additional funds for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on June 19, 2012:

SECTION TWO:

City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, including, but not limited to, the cost of pick-up and delivery of the materials, that PS Construction Fabric are the lowest and best bidders for the Project and have agreed to comply with all specifications for same.

SECTION THREE:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into agreements with PS Construction Fabric for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to PS Construction Fabric through the established purchase order procedures.

SECTION FOUR:

City Council appropriates Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) from the unappropriated balance of the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund to the Crack Fill Bid Account (201-2100-52411) for the Project.

SECTION FIVE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION SIX:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. The City needs to begin purchasing the needed materials immediately. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
