**A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE CONTRACT TO ST. CLAIR/PAVLIS GROUP FOR THE BOETTLER PARK RESTROOM PROJECT (“PROJECT”), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a “Notice to Bidders” in the Akron Beacon Journal on Thursday, October 11, 2012 and Thursday, October 18, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, October 26, 2012, the Parks and Recreation Superintendent opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Superintendent has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to St. Clair/Pavlis Group as the lowest and best bidder for the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

The City received and opened the following bids on Friday, October 26, 2012:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into agreement with St. Clair/Pavlis Group for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to St. Clair/Pavlis Group through the established purchase order procedures.

**SECTION FOUR:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were

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in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FIVE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
