

**RESOLUTION NO.:** 2011-R12

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO HIRE THE ARCHITECTURAL FIRM OF CHAMBERS, MURPHY, AND BURGE RESTORATION ARCHITECTS, LTD TO PERFORM ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES REGARDING THE LEVI J. HARTONG HOUSE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Green pursued and obtained a Local Government Fund grant from the State of Ohio through the Ohio Historic Preservation Office to partially pay for architectural services necessary to develop, plan, and proceed with the renovation with the Levi J. Hartong House and Farm; and

WHEREAS, Chambers, Murphy, and Burge Restoration Architects specialize in the restoration of historical structures; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Historic Preservation Office has reviewed the proposed contract and approved it; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a contract with Chambers, Murphy, and Burge Restoration Architects, Ltd for architectural services at a cost of Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$16,800).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN:**

**SECTION ONE:**

City Council approves contract between the City of Green and Chambers, Murphy and Burge Restoration Architects, Ltd for architectural services related to the Levi J. Hartong House and Farm.

**SECTION TWO:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION THREE:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
