A RESOLUTION MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO ALLOW THE FIRE DIVISION TO ACCEPT A GRANT THROUGH THE SAFETYGRANTS PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation administers the SafetyGRANTS Program which issues grants to employer's to defray the cost incurred for the purchase of ergonomic, safety and/or industrial hygiene equipment. The grant funds are available to employers for projects which substantiately reduce or eliminate the risk of work place injuries and illnesses; and

WHEREAS, City Council previously authorized the City to apply for grant funds administer through the SafetyGRANTS Program to allow the City to purchase two (2) truck mounted crash attenuators and arrow boards; and

WHEREAS, the City did receive a grant to help defray the cost of purchasing two (2) truck mounted crash attenuators and arrow boards; and

WHEREAS, the SafetyGRANTS Program limits a Community to receiving Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) in grant-funds in any two (2) year period; and

WHEREAS, the City applied to receive grant funds in order to purchase three (3) Power Pro Ambulance Cots for use by the Fire Division; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation approved the grant application for the purchase of the three (3) Power Pro Ambulance Cots; however, the City is only entitled to receive Nineteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars and Forty-Eight Cents (\$19,957.48) from the SafetyGRANTS Program; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of purchasing three (3) Power Pro Ambulance Cots is Fifty Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Six Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents (\$50,856.96); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make an additional appropriation to permit the Fire Division to purchase three (3) Power Pro Ambulance Cots; and

WHEREAS, after applying the available SafetyGRANTS funds of Nineteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars and Forty-Eight Cents (\$19,957.48), the net cost of three (3) Power Pro Ambulance Cots purchased for the Fire Division will be Thirty Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars and Forty-Eight Cents (\$30,899.48).

SECTION ONE:

City Council makes an additional appropriation of Fifty Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Six Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents (\$50,856.96) from the unappropriated balance of the Ambulance Transportation Fund to the Furniture & Equipment Account (218-3220-53640) to allow the purchase of three (3) Power Pro Ambulance Cots for the City of Green Fire Division.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this City and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
