



## Frequently Asked Questions

Here are a few questions that you, your employees or your customers may have.

### **Q Why is this project necessary?**

The two roundabouts going in at Massillon Road at Corporate Woods Circle/Thorn Drive and at Boettler Road and Franks Parkway will enable traffic going north and south to move through the corridor more efficiently, make it easier to enter and leave places of business along the corridor, and be a safer alternative to traditional traffic signal intersections. Meanwhile, the project also allows the City to maintain or accommodate growth in terms of vehicles on the road and businesses along the corridor, while improving the overall aesthetics of the corridor.

### **Q Is this a continuation of the 241 North project?**

Technically, this is a separate project with a new contractor. But it does involve many of the same elements completed on 241 North, including the construction of roundabouts, sidewalks and new landscaping. When it is complete, the 241 corridor through Green will offer a vastly improved traffic flow from Turkeyfoot Lake Road all the way to Steese Road.

### **Q Will the same construction company be working on it as before? Why or why not?**

No. Karvo Companies did the work of the North project. DiGioia-Suburban Excavating, LLC, will build on the 241 South project. The City's project manager, Zachary Kimble of Anser Advisory, returns for this project. Each construction project includes a bidding phase, where the company with the lowest and best bid is awarded the project.

### **Q How long will the project take?**

Depending on weather, supply chain and ongoing planning, the project is slated to begin July 2022 and is expected to be completed late fall of 2023.

### **Q Will 241 South be closed at all during construction?**

The corridor will remain open to traffic at all times; there will be no detour needed for the project. In other words, you will always be able to drive from one end (from East Turkeyfoot Lake Road) to the other (Steese Road). If unforeseen incidents occur (weather damage or accidents, for example), there may be temporary road closures and detours until things are back to normal again.



### **Will other roads near 241 South be closed during construction?**

At some point during construction, Franks Parkway and Thorn Drive will both be closed. At other times, Boettler Road and Corporate Woods Circle will be closed, though not at the same time.

The City will send text alerts, emails and update social media with any information on these side road closures and suggested travel re-routes.



### **For customers and employees, how will access to my business shift or change during construction?**

For the duration of this project, there will be adequate access to your place of business, and the City will do all it can to make this access as smooth as possible. Access points may change, and we will work with you to find the easiest routes to take to and from your business depending on where your customers and employees travel from.
