

**ORDINANCE NO.: 2007-6**  
**SPONSOR: MAYOR CROGHAN**  
**INTRODUCED: APRIL 24, 2007**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION AND PUBLICATION OF NEW MATTER IN THE UPDATED AND REVISED CODIFIED ORDINANCES; REPEALING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT WITH THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation has completed its annual updating and revision of the Codified Ordinances of the City, and

WHEREAS, various Ordinances and Resolutions of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council since the date of the last updating and revision of the Codified Ordinances (July 31, 2006), and have been included in the Codified Ordinances of the City, and

WHEREAS, certain changes were made in the Codified Ordinances to bring City law into conformity with State law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

**SECTION ONE:**

The editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following Ordinances and Resolutions and parts of Ordinances and Resolutions are approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of the City, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances:

**SECTION TWO:**

The following sections and subsections of the Codified Ordinances are or contain new matter in the Codified Ordinances and are approved, adopted and enacted:

**SECTION THREE:**

The following sections are repealed:

**SECTION FOUR:**

Pursuant to Ohio R.C. 731.23 and Section 4.11 of the Charter of the City, the Clerk of Council shall cause to be posted, for a minimum period of two weeks, in at least five public places within the City, a notice of the enactment of this Ordinance, containing the title of this Ordinance and a summary of the new matter approved, adopted and enacted in Section Two, which summary is attached as Exhibit A. The Clerk of Council shall also cause to be published a concise summary of this Ordinance in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the City once a week for two consecutive weeks.

**SECTION FIVE:**

All Ordinances and Resolutions or parts of the Ordinances and Resolutions which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of the new matter adopted in Section Two of this Ordinance are repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance except as follows:

- (a) The enactment of such sections and subsections shall not be construed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of such enactment, or an action or proceeding for the enforcement of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision, or to affect an indictment or prosecution. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for the purpose of revision and recodification.
- (b) The repeal provided above shall not affect any legislation enacted subsequent to December 31, 2006.

**SECTION SIX:**

Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare and morals of the citizens of the City, for the reason that it is necessary to have a current codification of the legislation of the City, one which is consistent with State law, as required by Article XVIII, Section 3, of the Ohio Constitution, to properly provide for the administration of government and to assure law and order in the City, for which reasons this Ordinance, including the 2006-B Replacement Pages which are approved, adopted and enacted, shall take effect immediately.
