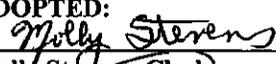
**SECTION TWO:**

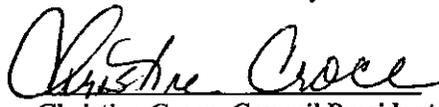

**SECTION THREE:**

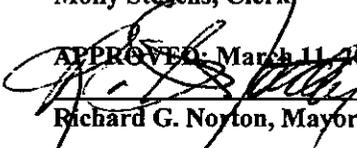
