WHEREAS, the City of Green is pursuing and planning many potential Capital Improvement Projects including, CAK International Business Park, Phase III at Port Green and Massillon Road (SR 241) North Improvements; and

WHEREAS, funding may be available in Fiscal Year 2010 2011 from the Federal Appropriations Budget for these Capital Improvement Projects; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Green to file grant applications to attempt to obtain funds to pay for these projects from the Fiscal Year 2010 2011 Federal Appropriations Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes the Mayor or his designee to file grant applications for funding consideration through the Fiscal Year 2010 2011 Federal Appropriations Budget for the CAK International Business Park, Phase III at Port Green and Massillon Road (SR 241) North Improvements projects.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:


