A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO MARK SCHAFFER EXCAVATING & TRUCKING, INC FOR THE CAK INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS PARK PHASE III AT PORT GREEN PROJECT ("PROJECT"), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a "Notice to Bidders" in the Akron Beacon Journal on Thursday, May 23, 2013; Thursday, May 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, June 11, 2013, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Mark Schaffer Excavating & Trucking, Inc as the lowest and best bidder for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

SECTION THREE:



SECTION FOUR:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FIVE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green because commencement of the Project at the earliest possible time will allow the City and its contractor to take advantage of the summer weather conditions. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
