A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO LOCKHART CONCRETE CO FOR THE MEADOW WOOD LANE/SUNNYVIEW DRIVE STORM WATER SCREENS PROJECT (“PROJECT”), MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF ONE HUNDRED TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$102,300.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a “Notice to Bidders” for the Project in the Akron Beacon Journal on Tuesday, October 1, 2013 and Tuesday, October 8, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on Wednesday, October 16, 2013, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Lockhart Concrete Co as the lowest and best bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate additional funds to award the contract for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on Wednesday, October 16, 2013:

SECTION TWO:

SECTION THREE:

City Council authorizes the appropriation of One Hundred Two Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$102,300.00) to the Meadow Wood Lane/Sunnyview Drive Storm Water Screens Project Account (201-2300-53636) from the unappropriated balance of the Street Construction and Maintenance Fund.

SECTION FOUR:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into agreement with Lockhart Concrete Co for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to Lockhart Concrete Co through the established purchase order procedures.


SECTION FIVE:

SECTION SIX:


